

## SHELLEY COLLEGE ASSESSMENT WEEKS MARCH 2021

Dear Year 11 and 13 Student,

I hope you are all well and managing to keep yourselves safe. Let me first speak on behalf of all staff to let you know we are missing having you inside the school building, normal school days seem a distant memory but we must hope that as soon as it is safe to do so our classrooms, corridors and social spaces will return to normal.

Every member of staff I have spoken to speaks of how proud and happy they are with your continued commitment to your studies, your use of and engagement with the remote teaching methods will pay dividends for you all.

On the 22<sup>nd</sup> of February we hope to have some more guidance as to how your grades will be generated this year, soon after this date the school will be back in touch to help explain how we will implement the decisions made.

As part of the process of gathering information to help with the generation of your grade we have set aside two weeks as assessment weeks, these being the week commencing Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March and the week commencing Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March. In these weeks, you will sit an exam for all your subjects.

Attached to this letter is a timetable of when the exams will run for both weeks to allow you to plan your revision. If applicable, your teacher will be getting in touch with you about the assessments being run to provide additional information. A few subjects are running their assessments in a different manner, so you will not see some subjects on the timetable.

An assessment week Microsoft Team has been created for both assessment weeks, with all students added, these will go live in late February. At the time stated in the exam timetable the exams team will make the assessment live for you. Please only sit assessments for the subjects that you are undertaking.

All assessments will last between 45 minutes and 1 hour, and assessments handed in late will be not be marked. During the weeks when you are not taking an assessment you will be expected to attend your lesson as normal. In due time your papers will be marked with percentages and these will be returned to you. We are still waiting on information as to whether the second exam week will be able to be conducted in school time, when this is known it will be shared.

The formal times that the sessions will start are in the table below, these are the same as your normal remote lesson timings. Please note that Period 1 starts at 08:40.

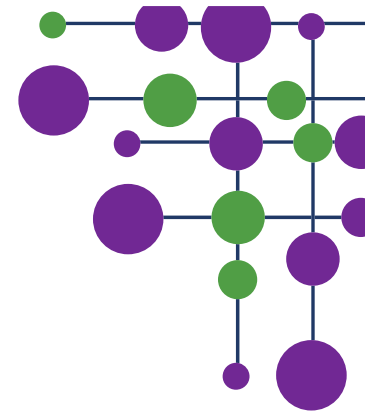

Students with access arrangements in place will be invited into school to sit these exams, this will come out as a separate letter after half term.

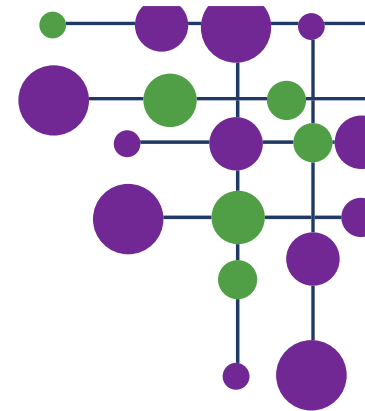
