Planned Delivery

Tuition is to be delivered in varying group sizes depending on the gaps and breadth of the gaps identified in the assessments.

Academic skills tutoring is also provided for students where the need is identified.

Statement

Statement on how we will use the funding in line with the DfE guidance on prioritising support for disadvantaged students.

As recognised the in line with the need to support the improvement of the performance of disadvantaged pupils, not only measured in absolute attainment, as this has also risen across the student body, but in closing the progress gap. The understanding that disadvantage has a big influence on pupil's life chances should not be further exacerbated by the Covid-19 pandemic. To this effect we will use the Tuition Fund Allocated to close the progress gap for our bursary students alongside those identified as having gaps in their education due to the wide and varied impact of the pandemic.
