

Details of online learning for severe weather policy

Online Learning in the Event of School Closure in Extreme Weather

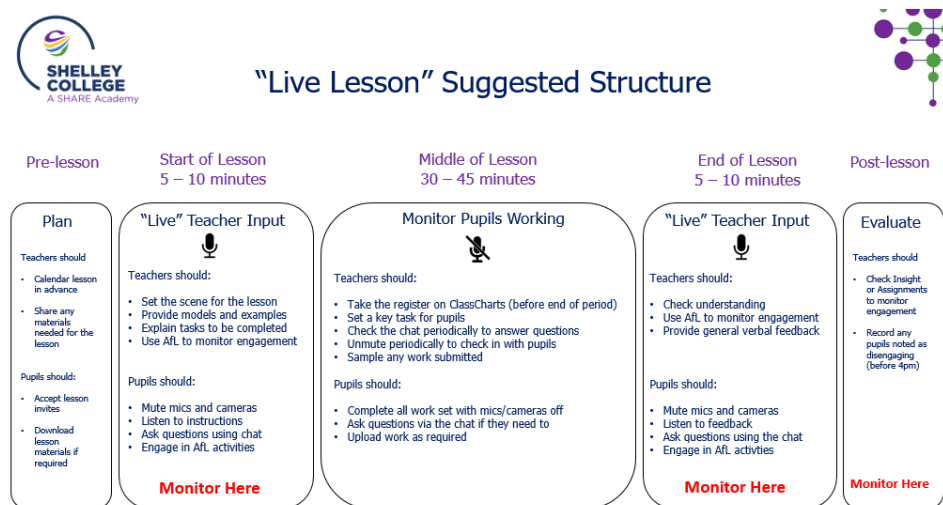
- In the event of school closure due to severe weather, pupils, wherever reasonably possible, will be expected to join “live lessons” through MS Teams on devices they may have at home.
- Pupils are given training and guidance on how to access live lessons in addition to the behaviour expectations for live lessons.
- Teachers are given training and guidance on how to deliver live lessons from home. They must follow the guidance in the SHARE MAT remote learning policy

Process for Accessing Live Lessons

- Pupils should log into MS teams and click on their calendar to view the lessons for the day.
- Pupils should click on the lesson and select “join” to access live lessons. They must join with their mics muted and their cameras off.
- Teachers will monitor attendance and engagement in live lessons for pupils who are able to join them

The Structure of Live Lessons

- At Shelley College, the structure of live lessons follows the structure below.



Behaviour Expectations in Live Lessons

- Pupils and teachers must follow the SHARE MAT remote learning compliance guide listed in the SHARE MAT remote learning policy.

In the event of pupils being unable to access live lessons

- Parents/carers who do not have devices/internet connections that enable their pupils to join live lessons should make contact with their child’s year leader via email.
- As school leaders learn of pupils who need support with access, reasonable measures will be taken to provide equipment and access where possible.

- If pupils do not have access to devices or an internet connection that enables them to join a lesson remotely in the event of school closure, pupils should continue with relevant independent study.
