Post 16 Options - A Levels



- ► The A Level (Advanced Level) is a subject-based qualification - Awarded as a General Certificate of Education (GCE)
- Level 3 Qualification worked towards over two years
- Students normally take 3-4 subjects
- AS Levels no longer awarded, and universities seek 3 A level grades as entry requirements
- A Level exams are taken in one sitting as a set of terminal exams (3 exams for the majority of subjects), and there is no coursework set for many subjects
- For A Levels which retain a coursework element, the percentage of the final grade determined by coursework has been reduced

Post 16 Options-Vocational Qualifications



- Vocational qualifications are work-related qualifications available in a wide range of career areas
- Designed to enable the learner to acquire knowledge and skills that meet recognised standards necessary to perform a particular job
- Different levels available:
- Level 1 Requires GCSEs at Grade 2
- Level 2 Requires GCSEs at Grade 3
- ▶ Level 3 (Extended Diploma) 4 or 5 GCSEs at Grade 9-4
- ▶ L3 Extended Diploma equates to 3 A Levels and qualifies a student for university on a related degree course

Apprenticeships



- Combine practical training in a job with study
- Available across a wide range of industries
- Different levels available
- Intermediate Level 2 equivalent to 5 GCSE 9-4
- Advanced Level 3 Equivalent to 3 A Level passes/ BTEC L3
- Require a training provider AND an employer
- CV, Covering letter, application skills
- Check start dates some will be too soon

Employment with Training

- Not as common these days
- Some good opportunities may be available
- Example: Employment in the retail sector with in-house training
- Risk at the end of employment students may have no nationally recognised qualifications




English and Maths requirement

For Maths and English, resitting is compulsory if you haven't achieved a pass (grade 4). You'll need to continue studying these subjects until you either pass or turn 18. If you achieved a pass in Maths and English, there's no requirement to resit, but you can if you'd like a higher mark.

College enrolment processes - things you need to look out for

- Accepting offers
 - Students should accept all offers they receive and keep them active until RESULTS DAY in August.
- ► GCSE results day 2024
 - ▶ 22 August 2024
- Enrolment
 - Once students have their results, they should contact the college they wish to attend first, in order to enrol. Once their place is confirmed they can inform the other colleges of their decision.
- Adjustment
 - ► Changing courses or subjects is usually OK in the first 2 weeks, but check with your college provider for their policy on this.
