HT1	Study Skills	Gatsby Benchmarks	H1, L1, L2, L3, L5, L9	As student move into 6th form, they need to be prepared for independent work at a higher level. Therefore, learning to be independent and take responsibility for their learning is essential for success.		
HT2	Health, Choices and Safety	RSE, SMSC: Social, Safeguarding, British Values	H4, H6, H9, H14, H15, H16, H17, H21, H22, H23, H24, R4, R5, R8	As students now have more independence, it is essential that they learn about independent activities such as holidays, festivals, and going to the club. They also learn first aid. Learning this at this point in the year ensures that students are equipped to make sensible choices regarding travel, alcohol, drugs, and festivals in the future. In this module, they also learn about expectations of professionalism and how to manage conflict in the workplace and in personal relationships.		
HT2	Navigating the wider world	SMSC, British Values, Gatsby benchmarks	R3, R19, R20, R21, R22, R23, R24, R25, L8, L9, L10, L11, L12, L23, L24, L25	Students must be prepared to work and be a positive citizen in multi-cultural Britain. This module is designed to build on their learning about professionalism and workplace values from the Progression module in Y12, focusing on Diversity and Inclusion and rights and laws in the workplace. The module also builds on HT1's learning about navigating conflict, adding nuance by discussing discrimination.	Adult finances - including budgetting, understanding salary deductions, illegal schemes and pyramid schemes, and consumer rights	L13, L14, L16, L19
