Dealing with disclosures

Listen to the student carefully, don't ask leading questions, don't promise confidentiality, record on CPOMS immediately, then pass on to a staff member with Safeguarding responsibility.

If an allegation is made against a staff member, report directly to Jack Wyatt or David Wadsworth.

Follow up with the person you have referred to in order to confirm appropriate action has been taken.

If you feel appropriate action has not been taken, contact duty and assessment. Key contact details for external agencies can be found in the Safeguarding Policy, or through liaison with the key staff in school.
