

Enrichment Activity	Description
Football Training	<i>Run by Paul Quinn, a semi-professional football coach and manager, spend Wednesday working on your skills, tactics and positional play for football. You will need to meet Paul on the field, fully changed with shin pads and boots at 1pm on Wednesdays.</i>
Netball	<i>Run by Miss Mountain with some student leadership opportunities too, on Wednesday P4 come and play netball in the PE Dept. You will need to come changed and ready to start at 1pm.</i>
Professional Skills	<i>A 6 week course, led by Mr Watson – careers advisor at Shelley College. Learn professional skills to prepare you for university/work on how to write emails, adapt CVs, covering letters, learn interview skills and more. A useful one for UCAS statements!</i>
Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)	<i>Run by Miss Baxendale, this is a year-long course with provides the opportunity to pursue your own project in your area of interest. This is good for supporting your application to competitive courses.</i>
British Sign Language	<i>Run by Pip Hurdley, take a 6-week course of 1 hour lessons 12.30-1.30pm on a Wednesday learning the basics of BSL.</i>
Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL)	<i>Worth UCAS points and run as an online course, TEFL is a good opportunity for those looking to build teaching and instructing skills, and also for those looking to possible work abroad – TEFL provides a qualification that will allow you to teach English across the world. A great course for supporting UCAS applications, this 120 hour online course is worth 8 UCAS points.</i>
FutureLearn Courses	<i>FutureLearn courses are run as an online course which you can complete in your own time, and in your own areas of interest. Some develop skills, some are teaching information, but there really is a course for everyone! This also is a great option to back up interest in topics when applying for university, and also to strengthen CVs when applying for jobs.</i>
Mandarin	<i>Run remotely by Lisa Wilkinson, a Mandarin teacher, students will be taken through the basics of mandarin and learning how to speak and write Mandarin. Useful for those with keen interest in international business/relations and also those who would love to learn another language!</i>

First Aid	<p><i>Run in school, this is a 3 week, 6 hour course that provides students with a first aid certificate – useful for all sorts of jobs and life skills!</i></p> <p><i>This is a very popular course so there is a limit on numbers – however there will be more opportunities to undertake this course throughout the year. Students will pick 2 options if undertaking this option to to length of course.</i></p>
Gold Duke of Edinburgh	<p><i>This is a 12-18 month activity (depending on whether you have completed Bronze/Silver DofE) where you will complete skill, physical and volunteering sections of your DofE. The enrichment time can be used to help you complete these activities. You will also take part in a 5 day residential and a 4 day expedition.</i></p>
Social Media Content Creation	<p><i>Working alongside Mrs Booth, create exciting content each week for the Shelley College 6th Form Instagram.</i></p>
Build a School in Kenya	<p><i>Organise and implement activities as part of a team to fundraise for BASIK and help students in Kenya have access to education, clean water and equipment.</i></p>
Charity/ Fundraising Society	<p><i>Starting with £10, work as a team to grow that money and fundraise for a charity of your choice!</i></p>
Student Council/Leadership	<p><i>Work with other students to run projects and campaigns to improve student experience in school.</i></p>
Work Placement	<p><i>Get experience in a career of your choice. This allocated time for work experience allows students to get experience in the local area in a career of their choice. This is a student-led activity, so they will need to research and organise the work placement themselves, and have the Manager send dates and timings of the placement to Miss Tovey in advance of commencing work placement to ensure that the workplaces are COVID compliant.</i></p>
Gardening & Grounds Management	<p><i>Spend time with others accessing the schools gardening facilities to improve the landscape of the school.</i></p>
Community Support Worker	<p><i>Spend time each week making links with local organisations and see how you can support those in the local community. Whether that means delivering shopping to those isolating or speaking to the elderly who may be lonely at home.</i></p>
